## Foundational Skills

Understanding Syllables
Syllable: Word part with ONE vowel sound (aeiouy)

Closed Syllable: One vowel followed by one or more consonants
-Vowel usually makes short vowel sound

Open Syllable: One vowel that is not followed by one or more consonants -Vowel usually makes long vowel sound

## Rules for Dividing Syllables

Every syllable has one vowel or vowel team.
-Place a dot under each vowel -Underline any vowel teams,
-Divide between two consonants
